It is the name of a supplier of e-books.

We have a number of books available on MyiLibrary, including the Understanding Public Health series. We are looking to increase the number of titles as they become available.

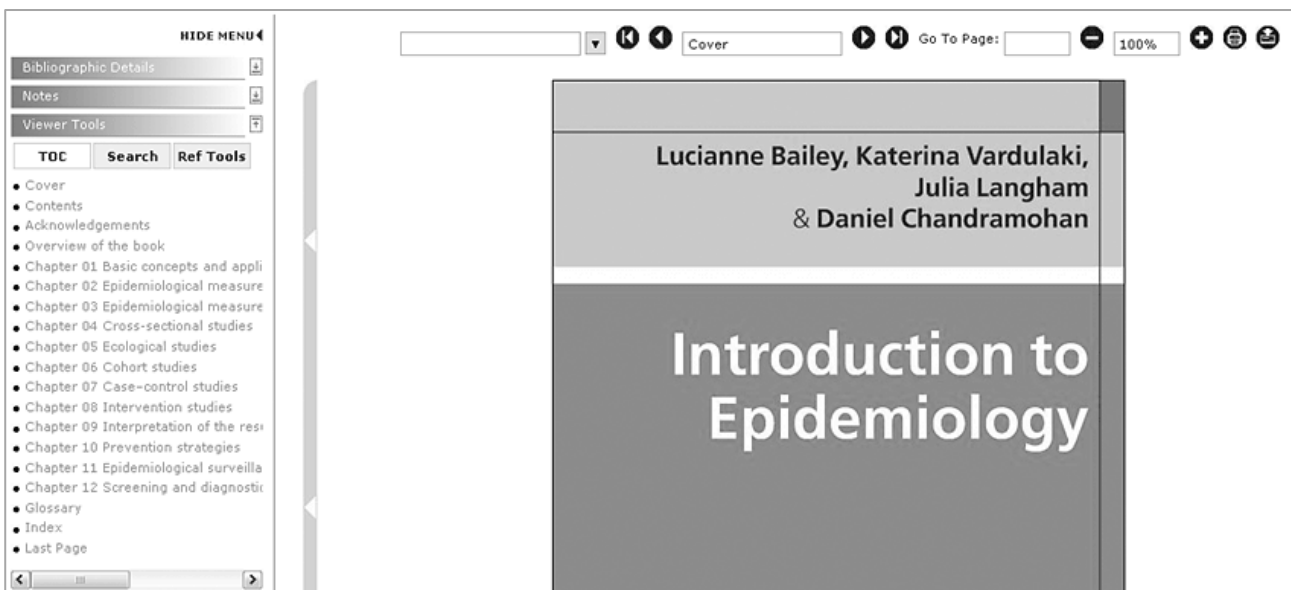
How do I get into MyiLibrary?

Go to <http://lib.myilibrary.com/> or click on the 'Electronic Access' link to the e-book from the Library Catalogue. If you are accessing remotely, enter your network username and password when prompted.

How do I find a book?

If you have followed a link from the Library Catalogue, this will take you directly to the book. The MyiLibrary homepage allows you to search for words in the title, author, keywords or publisher. You can also browse by subject or by publisher. Click on the title from your results to view the book.

How do I navigate through a book?



You can go to specific chapters by clicking on the relevant chapter title on the TOC listing on the left of the screen. Click the Search tab on the left of the screen to search within the text of the current book. The toolbar above the book allows you to move to specific chapters, navigate to specific pages, move forward and backwards through the book, increase or decrease the size of the pages and print or download pages.

Printing and downloading pages

Due to copyright restrictions placed by the publisher, you may only print or download 10 pages at a time.

Click the print or download icon on the right of the toolbar above the book. Enter the page numbers you wish to print or download. If you choose to download, you will be prompted to choose a location and name for your download. The file will be saved as a PDF.

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO PRINT OR DOWNLOAD MORE THAN 10 PAGES. IF YOU DO, THE TITLE WILL BE INACCESSIBLE TO THE WHOLE SCHOOL FOR SEVERAL HOURS.

Importing to EndNote

You can import book details directly from MyiLibrary into EndNote. Once you have viewed the book, click the Bibliographic Details option on the menu on the left. Choose the Export to EndNote option, you will be asked to choose an EndNote library to export to if you do not already have one open.

Saving notes

You can create an account on the MyiLibrary computer which allows you to save bookmarks and notes. Click My Account on the top right of the screen to create an account and login.

Once logged in, you can save notes next to specific pages of books. Just click the Notes option on the menu on the left and choose Add/View a note. To view your notes at a later time, just go back to this same option and click on the note to view it.
