10.30 Assemble at Westminster Pier, next to Westminster Bridge

11.00 Boat leaves Westminster Pier for Kew (takes approx. 1½ hours)

TRAVEL DETAILS

Westminster underground station is on the Circle Line and the District Line. The nearest British Rail station is Victoria (also on the Circle and District lines).

We will return to Central London from Kew using public transport. Most people leave from Kew Gardens which is next to the Tap on Line pub and has district line & overground services. Please note: **You do not have to return to LSHTM after the tour.**

PLEASE ALSO NOTE:

- Ask for a receipt for your return underground ticket when you buy it, as you may not be able to keep the ticket afterwards. Hand this to the Programme Administrator for reimbursement of your travel cost.
- If any of you wish to bring friends or relatives, you are welcome. However, they will have to cover their own expenses (i.e. cost of the boat and the return fare). If you are planning this, *please also let us know in advance so we can confirm final group numbers / spaces may be limited with priority for students*
