- Year 3: Data analysis, write and submit thesis


Map of Buildings



Grade point	Descriptor	Typical work
5	Excellent	Excellent engagement, insight, and argument
4	Very Good	Depth of understanding and insight – may have some inaccuracies
3	Good	Good, reasonable, clear
2	Satisfactory	Adequate engagement, routine argument and analysis
1	Unsatisfactory / poor (fail)	Gaps in understanding, poor argument and analysis
0	Very poor (fail)	Poor engagement and argument, limited understanding, may not have submitted




Library resources/Study spaces
