Personal Statement	PhD applicants should include details of working in relevant fields of your research experience and how the LSHTM/NU can contribute to your career plans. It is desirable, where possible, to add in any experiences and/or collaborations in Japan (Max.1,500 words).
Research proposal	All applicants are expected to submit a research proposal with their application. The research proposal should not exceed 4 pages and should include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Research/topic area • Specific research question(s) • Study design • Data collection method and analysis • Approximate research costs and planned funding source <p>Please be aware that the research proposal submitted with your application does not have to be the final research project: if and when you are offered a place, you will have the opportunity to refine your project through discussions with your supervisor.</p> <p>The main purpose of the proposal is to demonstrate that you have the necessary critical thinking skills, an understanding of the relevant research area, and an appreciation of the demands of a Research Degree.</p>
Relevant Professional Qualifications	A qualification appropriate to the course of study to be followed, in medicine, dentistry or veterinary studies
Evidence of English language ability	Band B (standard requirement) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cambridge Advanced English (CAE) :185 • IELTS (Academic) : 7.0 • Pearson PTE Academic: 68 • TOEFL IBT: 100 <p>*These tests are only valid for 2 years. The English test score must have been completed no more than 2 years prior to enrolment. Prospective research students must meet above the English language requirements by the time of admission in September 2020. If your current test is below these requirements, please contact LSHTM Admissions team to discuss available options.</p>
