her rent for a few weeks. but I shall be very glad if you will make arrangements for us to go to Chilfome as soon as possible as Miss Alexander is fretting for her own home and doesn't get on as well as I could wish. Her nerves are in a very bad state & I have had to put her under the care of our local Doctor. I also had to have the Dentist & Dr out last week to extract three teeth which were causing her a lot of pain on account of bad abscess, this again has put her back quite a lot.

I am giving her Sanatogen Wine & Vegamine tablets every day in addition to the Dr's medicine, also an occasional glass of Stout. This is with the Dr's sanction, but I feel the real cure rests at Chilfome as in the back of her mind is the fear we are not taking her back & her Car & things will be sold. There was a suggestion her car might be sold but she is

very much opposed to this being done as
she bought it with her Father's Legacy
& is looking forward to visiting her own
people. When the weather gets warmer,
Miss Alexander has asked me to ask you
to forward her £3-0-0 for her personal use.
