✿ It has been an eventful few weeks since our last newsletter. Thank you all for your work in screening, recruiting, entering data and following up participants.

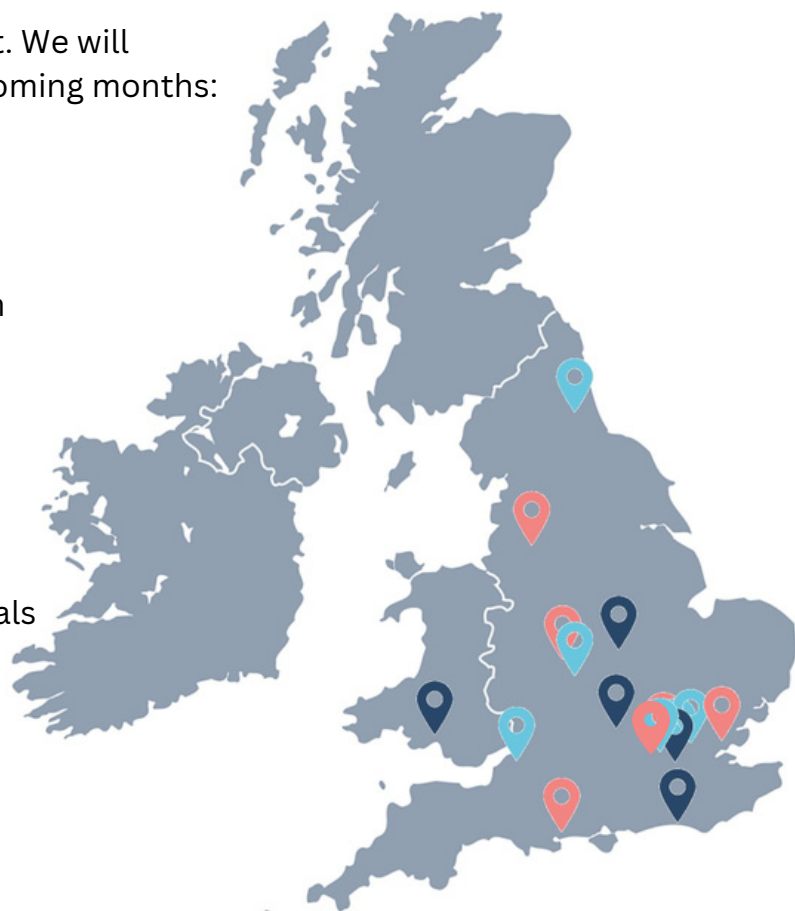

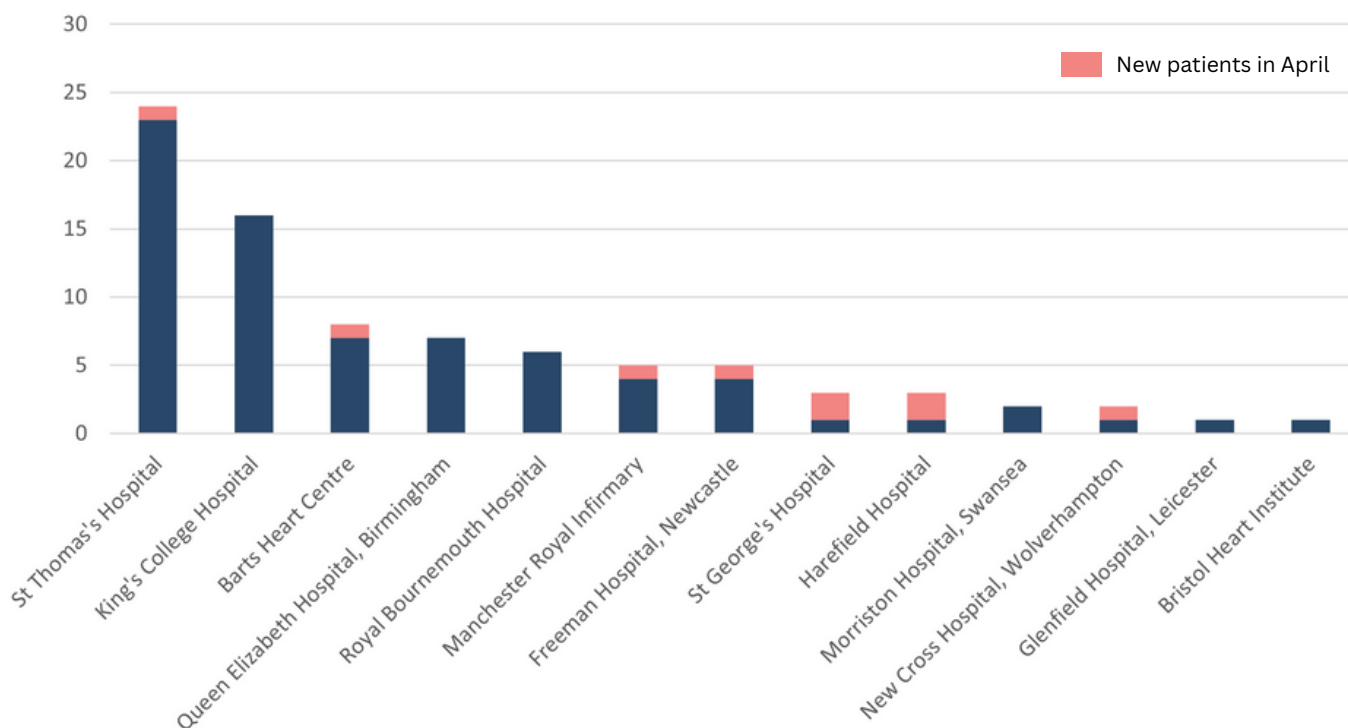
