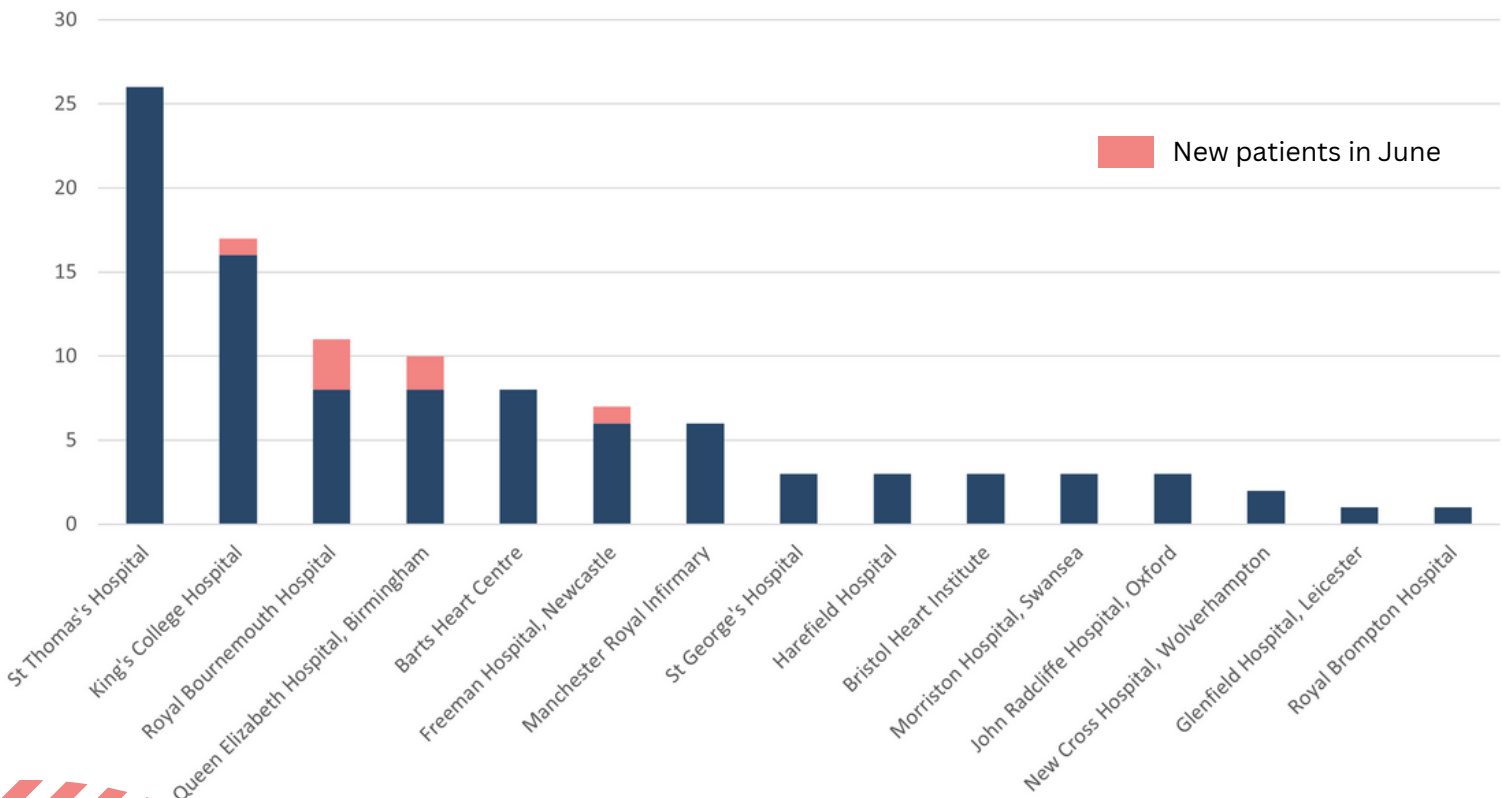

 A reminder to sites that ETC funding has increased, and that all Q1 recruitment uploads to CPMS will be reimbursed with new ETC amount. 



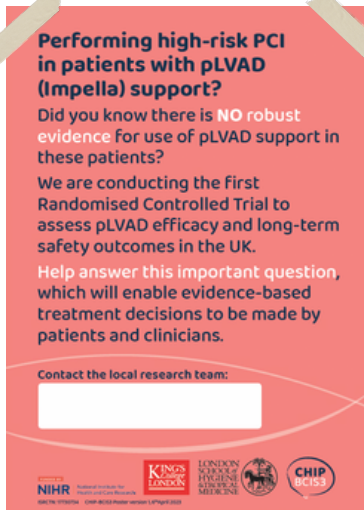
Video PIS
