STATEMENT OF INCORPORATION AND CHARITABLE STATUS

The London School of Hygiene & Tropical Medicine's Gift Aid reference number is **X28731**.

The School was incorporated by Royal Charter on 1 April 1924. The Charter can be found at:

Clause 1 of the Charter establishes the School as "one Body Corporate" and clause 1a) establishes that it has "all the powers of a natural person". Clause 6 establishes that "The Council shall be the supreme governing body of the London School".

With regard to the School's charitable status, the School is an exempt charity within the meaning of Schedule 3 of the UK Charities Act 2011 (formerly Schedule 2 of the 1993 Act) and as such is a charity within the meaning of Section 506(1) of the Taxes Act (ICTA) 1988. Exempt charities are not required to be registered with the Charity Commissioners. However, on 1 June 2010, the Higher Education Funding Council for England became the principal regulator of those English higher education institutions (HEIs) which are exempt charities.
