



General conditions for issuing a CAS:

The Registry will not issue an applicant a CAS in the following circumstances:

- If the applicant has not met all of the offer conditions for their course.
- If the applicant's course at the School will not represent academic progression as defined in the Tier 4 Sponsor Guidance.
- If the applicant's course at the School would exceed the time limit on Tier 4 study outlined in the Tier 4 Sponsor Guidance.
- If the applicant has not provided supporting documents that fully meet the requirements for Tier 4. This includes but is not limited to financial evidence for maintenance funds.
- If the applicant provides false or incorrect information on their CAS Request Form or in correspondence with the School.
- If the School has reason to believe that the visa application will be refused, or that an application will not be made in accordance with the Immigration Rules.
- If the applicant cannot demonstrate that they will be able to arrive at the School by their expected start date.
- If the School has reason to believe that the applicant will not comply with the conditions of their permission to stay in the UK.
