I am a paediatric trainee with an interest in infection biology and anti-microbial resistance. I am leading the FIEBRE systematic review on dengue diagnostics which is an enormous but exciting project - particularly given there are no large scale meta-analyses estimating

sensitivity and specificity of diagnostic tests for dengue (11,000 abstracts have been screened).

My MSc project at LSHTM was with the Mostowy laboratory focused on host-pathogen interactions in Shigella infection. Currently, I'm working as a Clinical Research Fellow at the Centre for Neonatal and Paediatric Infection (CNPI) in St George's University, working on the NeoSep trial which aims to evaluate novel antibiotic combinations for neonatal sepsis. Ultimately, I would like to become a clinical academic in paediatric infectious diseases.
