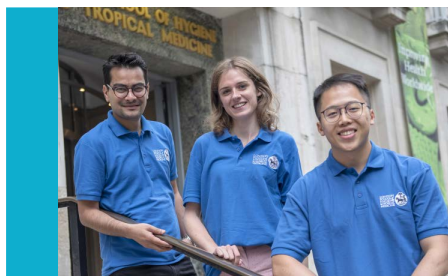

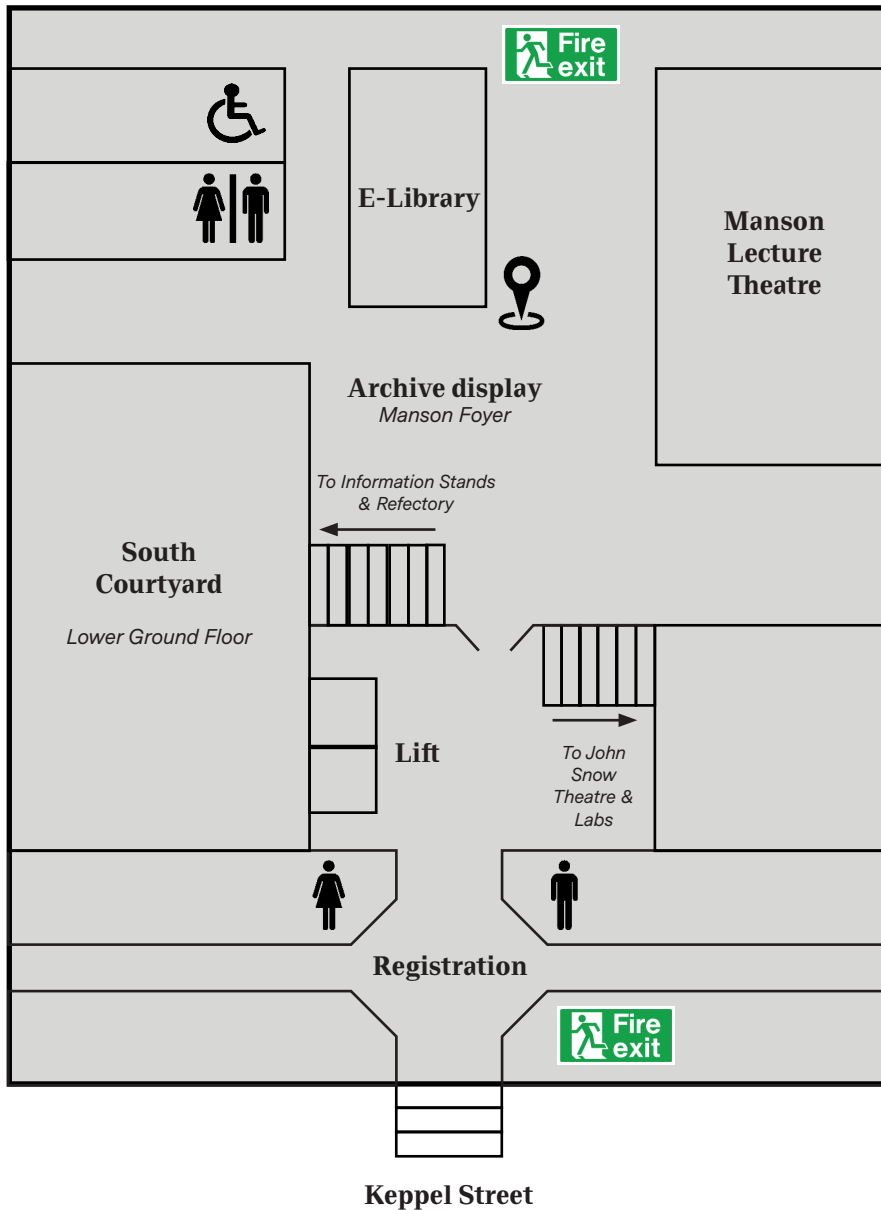

Tour Meeting Point

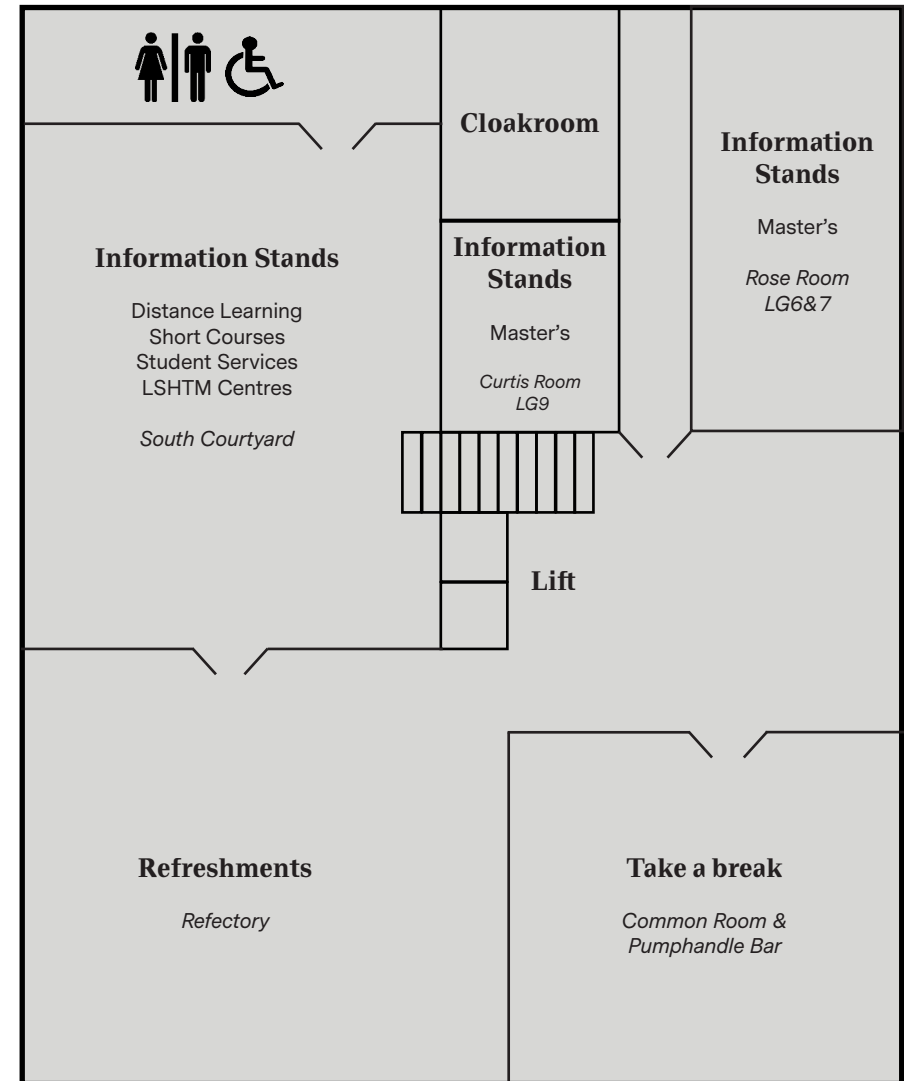


Toilets
